

## Registered Nurse

**Job Description:** Deliver mobile care, administer client medication, problem solve any medication issues including pharmacy pickups and insurance, develop treatment plans for medication management, schedule, draw and monitor labs ongoing, conduct medication adherence counseling and determine best intervention based on clients acuity

**Acuity Indexes:** Medication Adherence, Health Literacy

<b>PHARMACY AND MEDICINE</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• What Pharmacy?</li> <li>• What insurance?</li> <li>• Assess weekly and manage any changes to both</li> </ul>		
<b>HIV PRIMARY CARE</b>  If acuity=1/2 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Intake</li> <li>• Schedule and monitor regular labs</li> </ul>		
<b>COMPLEX CARE MANAGEMENT</b> Daily/Weekly		
<b>ACUTE CARE</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Assist MD with urgent issues</li> </ul>		
<b>ADHERENCE</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Acuity Scale Assessment used at intake, monthly and on going</li> </ul> If acuity=1/2 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Measuring success and report back</li> <li>• Identify what team support is needed</li> <li>• Ongoing counseling</li> </ul> If acuity=3 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Refer to MD</li> </ul> Are there resistance or adherence concerns? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If so, refer to team</li> </ul>		
<b>DISCHARGE</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Create treatment plan</li> <li>• Initiate discharge</li> </ul>
